- Any other topics that bring together these two areas

Submission Guidelines:

1. **Students submitting their papers are expected to have a proper understanding of the plagiarism issues. Nothing should be copied in any form without proper acknowledgement.**
2. We do not expect students to include anything that may turn out to be defamatory or promotional (Racial, Gender and Language bias).
3. The students are requested to send an “**Abstract**” and “**Keywords**” along with their papers.
4. They are instructed strictly to follow the **MLA style manual (7th or 8th edition)** or **Chicago Style Manual, 17th edition** before submission.
5. They need to submit their papers in **doc files (Ms Word)** only. Graphic materials need to be incorporated by the students in the text document.
6. Visual images like diagrams, pictures, maps will be highly appreciated. If possible, the students are requested to present these figures in the hyperlinked state.
7. The **word limit** of an article should be **within 2500-3500**.
