## Poster Design Competition — Rules & Guidelines

- 1. Eligibility-** The competition is open to all streams students at the B.A./B.Sc. M.A./M.Sc. Levels. Each participant may submit only one poster.
- 2. Theme-** Participants must choose one theme from the list provided by the organizing committee. The poster must reflect creativity, originality, and relevance to the chosen theme.
- 3. Poster Size-** Accepted sizes: A3 or A2. Both handmade and digital posters are permitted.
- 4. Submission Guidelines-**
  - Handmade posters should be neatly designed with clear visuals and colours.
  - Digital posters must be submitted in PDF or JPEG format.
  - The following details must be written clearly on the back of the poster or attached separately: Name of the student- Class / Semester-Institution Name-Contact Number
- 5. Originality-**
  - The poster must be entirely the participant's own work.
  - Use of copied materials, downloaded images, AI-generated posters, or plagiarised content is strictly prohibited.
  - Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.
- 6. Judging Criteria**
  - Creativity & Innovation – 25%
  - Relevance to the Theme – 25%
  - Artistic Presentation – 25%
  - Clarity & Impact of Message – 25%
- 7. Deadline-** Last date for submission: 10th December 2025  
(Late submissions will not be accepted.)
- 8. Prizes-** First Prize, Second Prize, Third Prize & Certificates will be awarded to all participants.





## Poster Design Competition — Rules & Guidelines

### 9. General Rules

- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- Participants must not include offensive, political, or sensitive content.
- Participants are responsible for bringing their own materials unless otherwise stated.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to modify the rules if necessary.

### 10. Online Submission

- Posters may also be submitted online.
- Participants must upload the poster in both formats:  
(a) PDF file (b) Image file (JPEG/PNG)

### 11. File Naming Format- Online files must be named as:

StudentName\_Class\_Institute\_Poster

Example: AnanyaSharma\_Sem2\_ABCCollege\_Poster

### 12. File Size Requirements

- PDF file size: Maximum 200 KB / 300 KB (choose your preferred limit).
- Image file size: Maximum 200 KB / 300 KB.  
(Files exceeding the size limit will not be accepted.)

### 13. Upload Guidelines

- Files must be clear, readable, and properly scanned.
- Blurry or illegible posters will be rejected.
- Digital posters must be high-quality but within the size limit.
