How to Reach Srikrishna College

Srikrishna College, Bagula, is well-connected and easily accessible by Rail, Road, & Air.

By Rail: Bagula Railway Station (Nadia) is located on the Ranaghat-Krishnanagar line. The college is only a few minutes' walking distance from the station or a 5-minute ride by toto/auto.

By Road: Regular bus and local transport services (toto/auto) are available from Ranaghat, Krishnanagar, Shantipur, Kalyani, and nearby areas. The college is easily reachable from Bagula Bazar More.

By Air: The nearest airport is Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport, Kolkata, located approximately 85–90 km from Bagula. From the airport, one can reach the college by taxi/cab to Ranaghat or directly to Bagula, or by taking a train from Sealdah railway station after a short road journey.

Nearby Towns: Ranaghat – Approx. 12 km | Krishnanagar – Approx. 18 km
Reaching the college is convenient from all surrounding regions.
