***Special Note to the authors:** Since all the papers are research reviews in nature, authors are requested to take care of the plagiarism and overlaps even from their own papers (overlap/similarity index from a single source should be less than 5%, while the overall overlap may be kept within 15% for the complete article). In case when authors take few sentences or a paragraph from their papers, they can make declarations of the same. The minimum length of the paper should be 7 pages and the maximum length should not cross 15 pages.
