Any disability ,liability ,restriction or condition with regards to -

- (a) access to shop ,public restaurants ,hotels and places of public entertainment or
- (b) The use of wells ,tanks, bathing ghats ,roads and places of public resort maintained wholly or partly out of state funds or dedicated to the use of the general public.

### **ARTICLE 16**

- (1) There shall be equality of opportunity for all citizens in matters relating to employment or appointment to any office under the state.
- (2) No citizen shall on grounds only of religion ,race ,caste ,sex, descent ,place of birth ,residence or any of them ,be intelligible for or discriminated against in respect or any employment or office under the state.
- (4) Nothing in this article shall prevent the state from making any provision for the reservation of appointments or posts in favour of any background class of citizens which in the opinion of the state is not adequately represented in the services under the state.

### **ARTICLE 17**

 Abolition of Untouchability – Untouchability is abolished and its practice in any form is forbidden the enforcement of any disability arising out of untouchability shall be an offence punishable in accordance with law.
