### 2. Background and Rationale

The Department of Political Science holds a freshers’ welcome to help newly admitted students settle into college life. The programme introduces them to the faculty, their seniors and the academic culture of the Department, and gives them a sense of belonging from the start. A farewell for the final-year students acknowledges the completion of their undergraduate journey and gives them an occasion to share their experiences and advice with their juniors.

This year both occasions were combined into a single programme. The incoming batch follows the four-year undergraduate curriculum framed under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, while the outgoing batch completed its studies under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The event therefore also brought together students from the two curricular frameworks under which the Department is currently teaching.

### 3. Objectives

- To welcome the new 1st semester students and help them feel at home in the Department.

- To introduce the freshers to the faculty members, their seniors and the academic and co-curricular life of the Department.
- To bid a formal farewell to the 6th semester students and recognise their contribution to the Department.
- To encourage outgoing students to share their experiences and guidance with their juniors.
- To strengthen the bond between batches and build a supportive departmental community.
- To give students a platform to plan and run a programme and to display their cultural talents.
