2. Background and Rationale

The Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution on 26 November 1949, and it came into force on 26 January 1950. Since 2015, the Government of India has observed 26 November every year as Constitution Day (Samvidhan Divas) to promote awareness of constitutional values among citizens and to honour the framers of the Constitution, particularly Dr. B. R. Ambedkar, Chairman of the Drafting Committee. The year 2025 marked the 76th anniversary of the adoption of the Constitution.

In keeping with this national observance, the Department of Political Science, together with its Club for Civil Services Aspirants, organised a one-day state-level seminar on the theme “Constitutional Values and Ethical Leadership”. The theme links the foundational ideals of the Constitution — justice, liberty, equality and fraternity — with the ethical conduct expected of leaders in public life, administration and civil society. It is directly relevant to the undergraduate Political Science curriculum and to students preparing for civil services and other competitive examinations, where Indian Polity and Ethics form core components.

3. Objectives

- To commemorate Constitution Day and acknowledge the contribution of the members of the Constituent Assembly, especially Dr. B. R. Ambedkar.
- To deepen students’ understanding of the core values enshrined in the Preamble — justice, liberty, equality, fraternity and the dignity of the individual.
- To examine the relationship between constitutional morality and ethical leadership in governance and public life.
- To sensitise students to Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties and the responsibilities of citizenship.
- To support civil services aspirants through academic engagement with themes of Indian Polity and Ethics, Integrity and Aptitude.
- To create a platform for inter-institutional academic interaction between students and experienced academicians.

6. Participation and Registration Analysis

Registration was conducted online through a Google Form. The response sheet was examined and cleaned before analysis so that each participant is counted only once. The summary below relates to the 133 unique students who registered on or before the date of the seminar.

6.3 Notes on the Registration Data

- The form recorded 199 responses. Of these, 53 were repeat submissions by the same individual, identified by matching the name with the phone number or e-mail address. After removing them, 146 unique individuals remain.
- 133 individuals registered on or before 26.11.2025; they are listed in Annexure II. Of these, 26 registered for the first time on the day of the seminar.
- 13 individuals submitted the form for the first time only after the seminar (between 30.11.2025 and 09.12.2025). They are listed separately in Annexure III and are not counted as participants in this report unless their presence is confirmed by the signed attendance register.
- Online registration is not proof of attendance. The number of students who actually attended should be taken from the signed attendance register, which is to be enclosed with this report.
- Three registrants entered “2nd semester” and four did not state their semester; these are shown as “Not stated / unclear”. The “Year of passing (for ex-students)” field was filled inconsistently, so alumni participation could not be established from the form.
- Names are reproduced as entered by the respondents, with capitalisation standardised. Contact numbers and e-mail addresses have been omitted from this report for privacy and are retained in the departmental records.

7. Outcomes

- Students engaged with the values of the Constitution beyond the classroom syllabus and were encouraged to relate constitutional morality to ethical conduct in leadership and public service.
- The programme drew registrations from all three running semesters (I, III and V), with first-semester students forming the largest group, which helps orient new entrants to the discipline early.
- Students gained academic exposure to three experienced resource persons from two other institutions, strengthening inter-institutional academic linkage.
- The Club for Civil Services Aspirants was able to extend its activities to a large student group on themes directly useful for competitive examinations.
