2. About the Club and Background

The Club for Civil Services Aspirants is an initiative of the Department of Political Science, Srikrishna College. It aims to guide and motivate undergraduate students who wish to pursue careers in the civil services, and to build awareness of the examinations, syllabus and preparation needed for them. Students enrolled in the Club through an online membership form circulated in

two phases, in July 2025 and September 2025. The form also collected WhatsApp numbers for the Club’s communication with members.

The event notice pointed out that the West Bengal Public Service Commission was likely to conduct three civil service examinations during the year, making it an important time for aspirants to plan their preparation in the right direction. In response, the Club organised an online interactive session with Sri Amit Kumar Bose, an experienced academic who had earlier addressed the College’s Constitution Day seminar in November 2025. The session was held in the evening in online mode so that students could join from home, outside regular class hours.

- To guide students on the structure, stages and demands of civil service examinations, with particular reference to those conducted by the West Bengal Public Service Commission.

- To advise aspirants on planning their preparation, choosing study resources and managing time.
- To give students a chance to clear their doubts directly with an experienced academic.
- To use the online mode to reach members of the Club beyond class hours.

5. Proceedings of the Session

The session was held on Google Meet on 29 January 2026 and was scheduled to begin at 8:00 P.M. Arijit Chowdhury welcomed the resource person and the participants and introduced the purpose of the session.

Sri Amit Kumar Bose then addressed the participants on preparation for civil service examinations. Screenshots taken at 8:09 P.M., 8:15 P.M. and 8:40 P.M. show him addressing the meeting, so the session ran for at least forty minutes. In the 8:40 P.M. screenshot, participants are seen using the “raise hand” feature, which shows that students were seeking to ask questions and take part in the discussion.

6.1 Online Attendance Recorded in Screenshots

These figures include the resource person, the host and any faculty members present. Google Meet groups some participants into a single tile, so the counts from the mobile screenshots are approximate. The 8:15 P.M. figure is taken from the participant counter and is the most reliable of the three.

6.2 Club Membership Base

The session was open to members of the Club. The membership form received 146 responses from 06.07.2025 to 01.10.2025. After repeat submissions were removed, 105 students remain, drawn from nine departments and a programme (general) course.

6.3 Notes on the Data

- The membership form is the Club’s enrolment record, not a registration form for this session. It shows the group of students the session was meant for, not who attended.
- Of the 146 membership responses, 41 were repeat submissions by the same person, identified by the phone number or by the e-mail address together with the surname. This leaves 105 unique members.
- Five members left the department field blank or entered their own name or course (for example “BA 1st year”); they are shown as “Not stated / unclear”. Entries “B.Sc. Program” and “General” are grouped as “Programme (General) Course”.
- Screenshots show only the display names used in Google Meet, which cannot be reliably matched with the membership list. The host’s Google Meet attendance or participant list should be attached as the formal attendance record, if it was exported.
- Names are reproduced as entered, with capitalisation standardised. Mobile numbers and e-mail addresses are omitted for privacy and retained in the Club’s records.

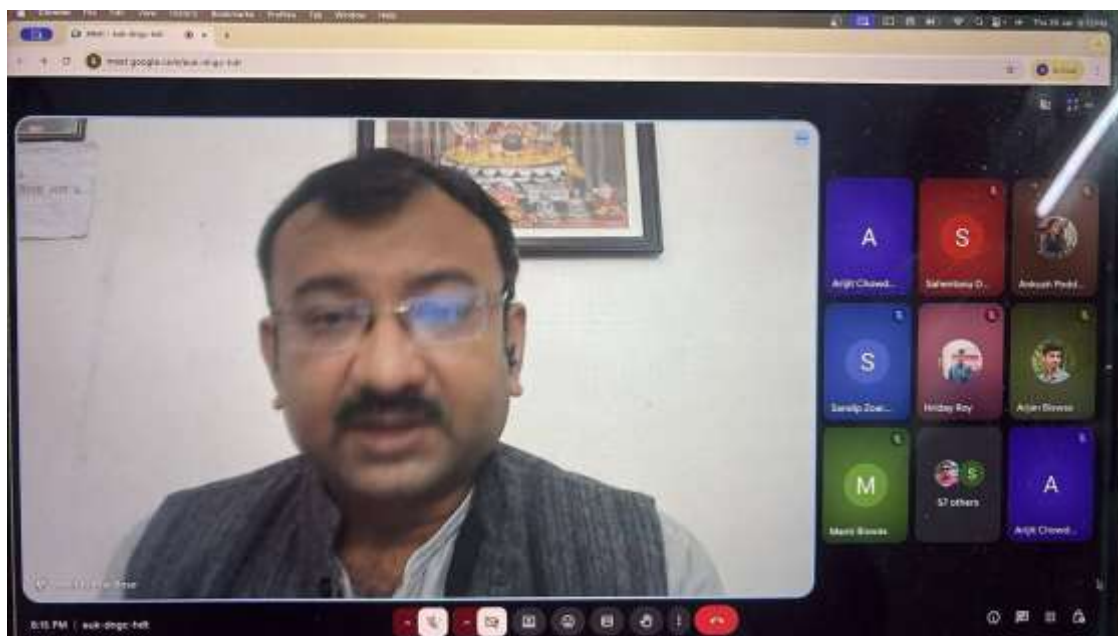
7. Outcomes

- About 66 participants joined the session at its peak, showing strong interest among students in civil service careers.
- Students received guidance on civil service examinations at a time when several state-level examinations were expected during the year.
- Students interacted directly with the resource person, as shown by the raised hands during the session.
- The online evening format allowed students to attend from home without affecting regular classes.
- The Club continued its engagement with Sri Amit Kumar Bose after the November 2025 seminar, building an ongoing mentoring link for aspirants.

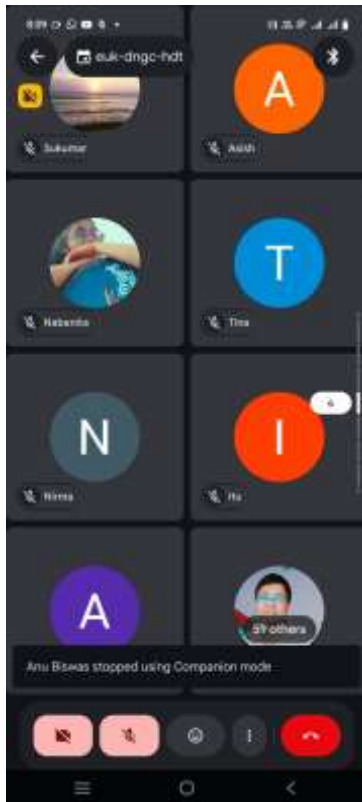

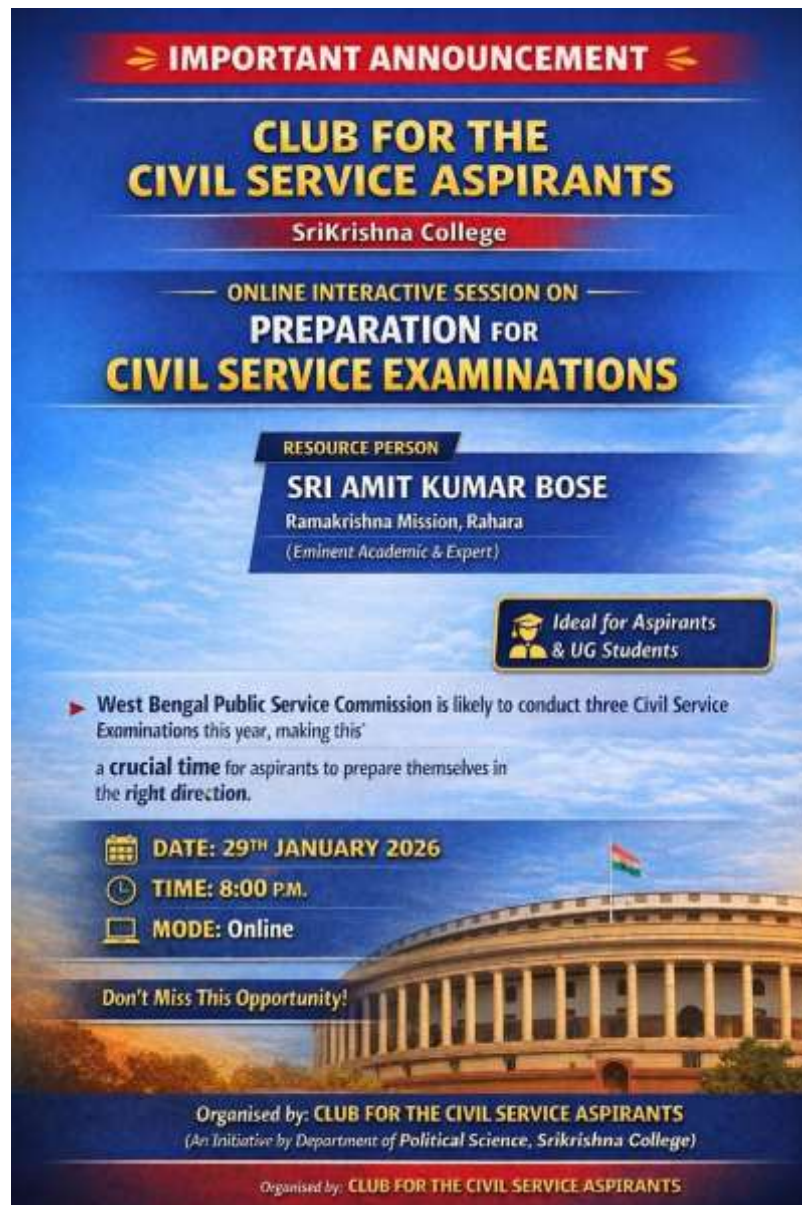


Screenshot 2: Participant grid on a mobile phone at 8:09 P.M., showing named tiles and “59 others”.
