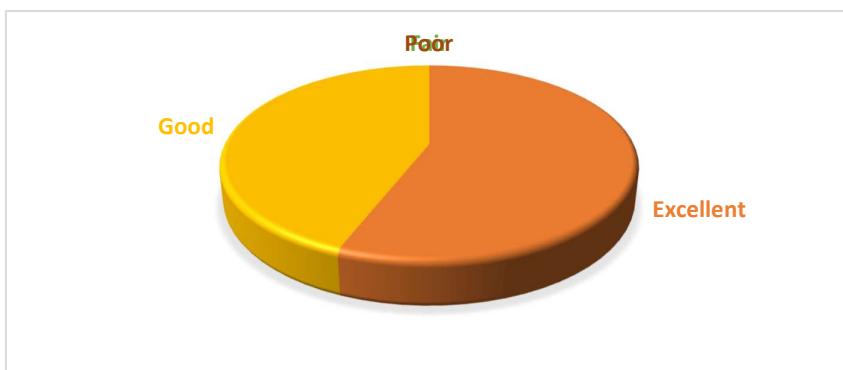

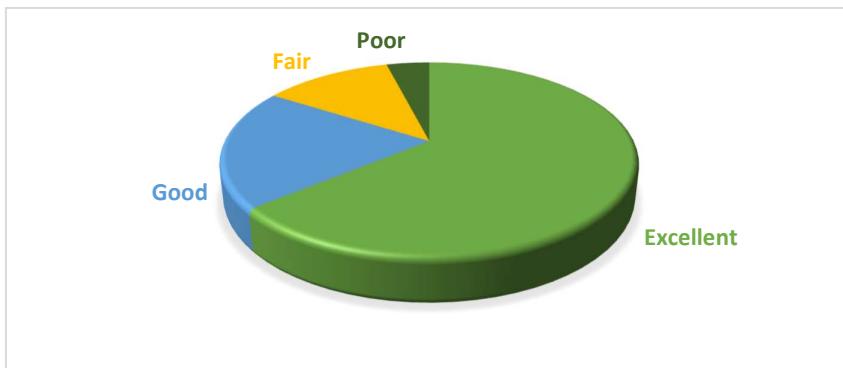
**1. How do you rate about admission procedure in this college?**

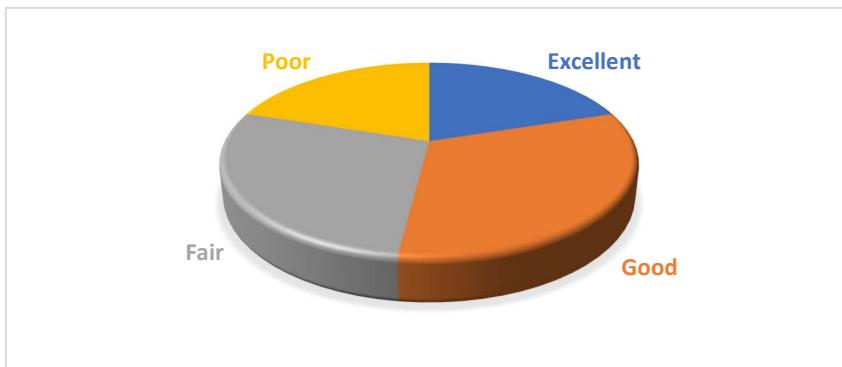
**2. How do you rate about the Alumni Association/Network?**

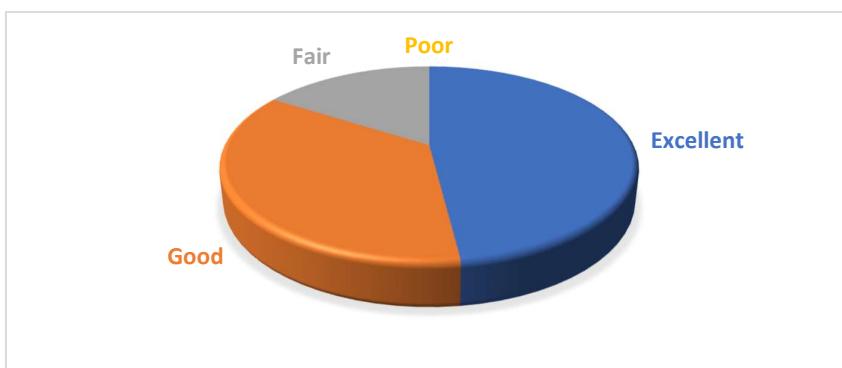
**3. Canteen Facilities in the college?**

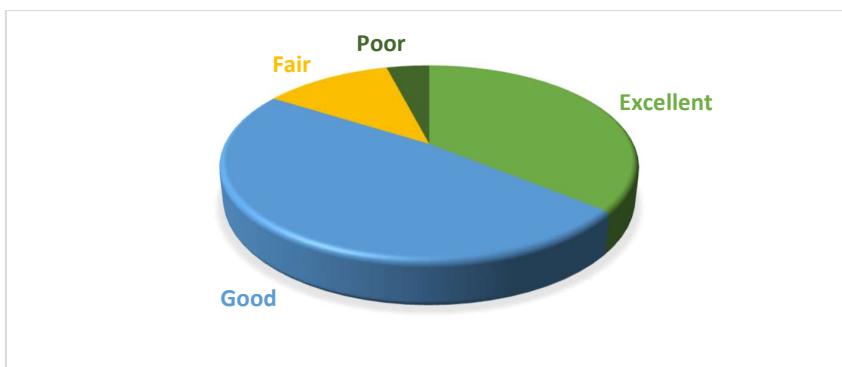
#### 4. Your view on the college ambience?

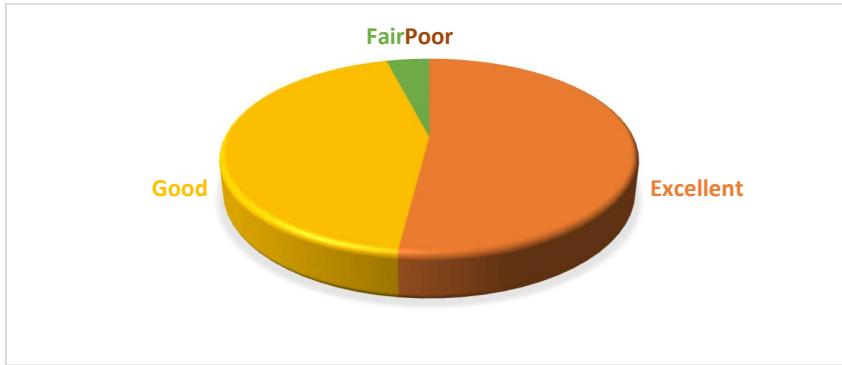
#### 5. Overall environment of the college?

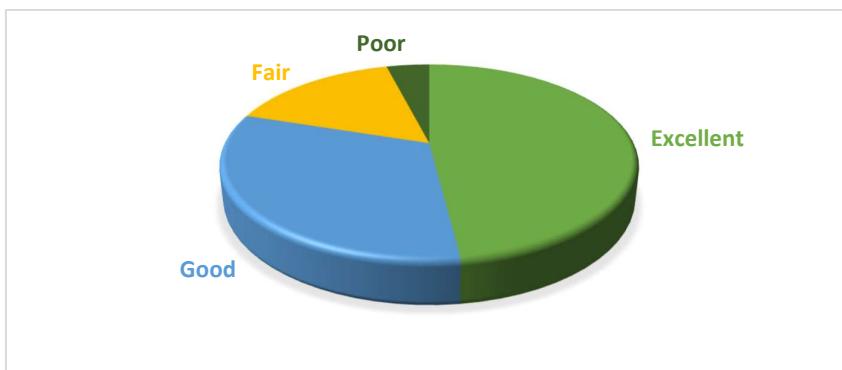

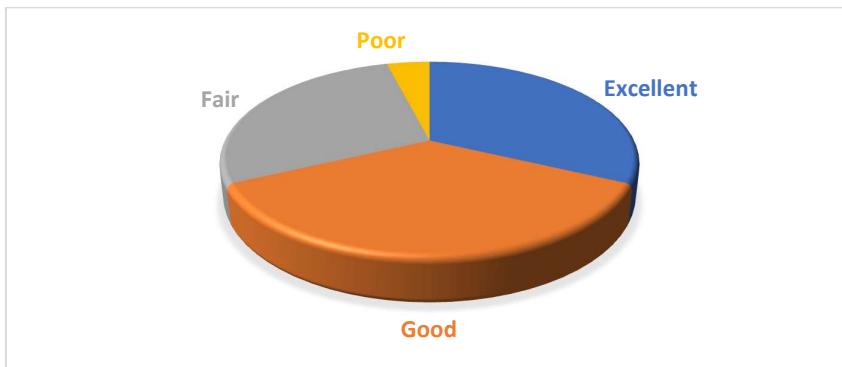
### 7. Fee structure of the college?

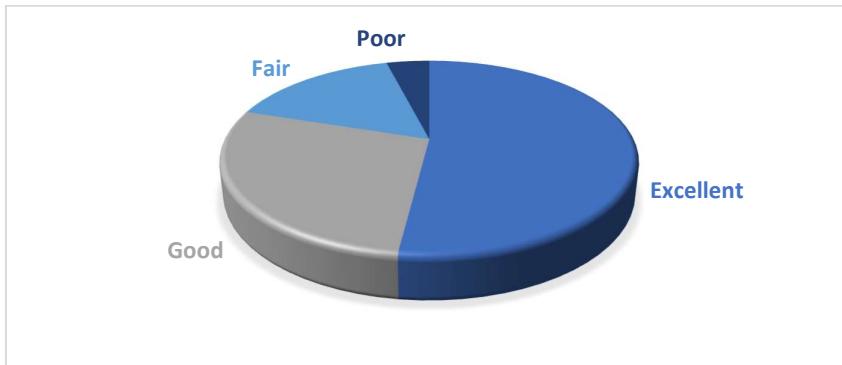
### 8. Extra-curricular activities ?

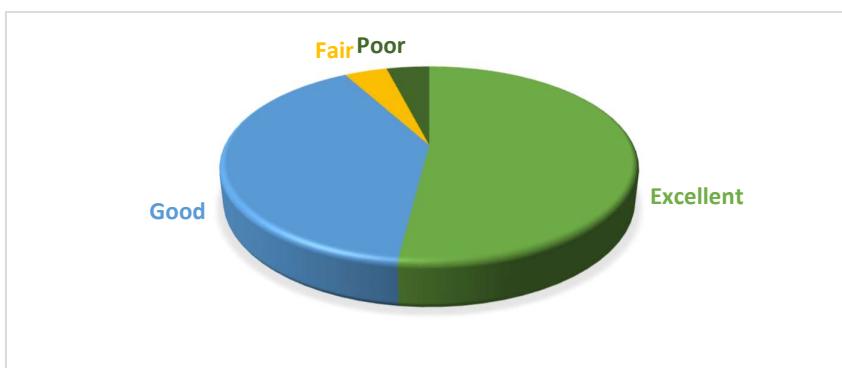
### 9. How do you rate the courses which are skills oriented?

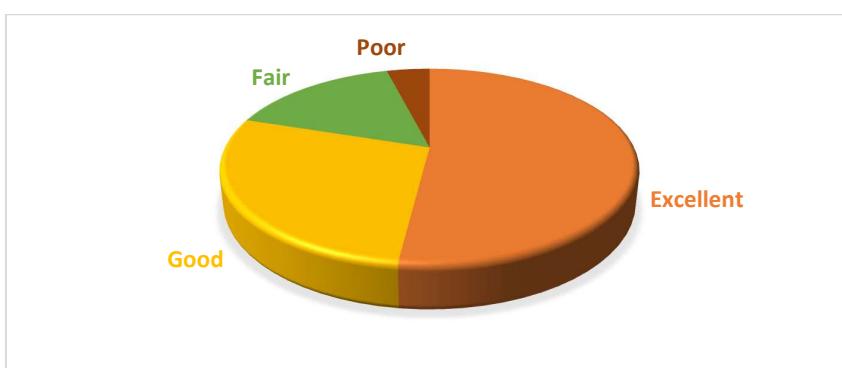
#### 10. How do you rate the learning experience in terms of teaching and learning?

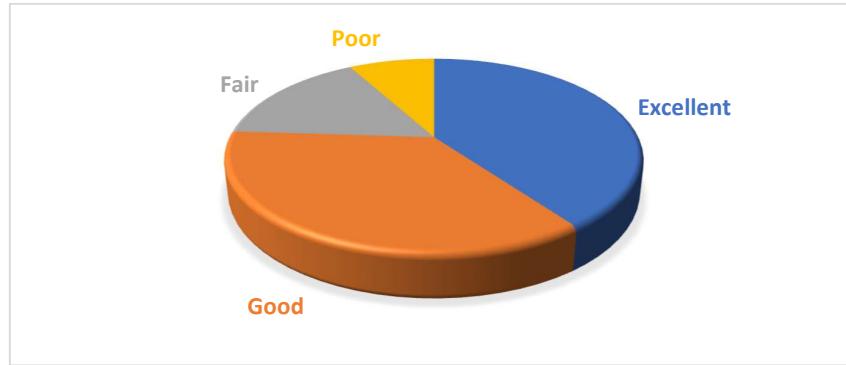
#### 11. Infrastructure & Lab facilities?

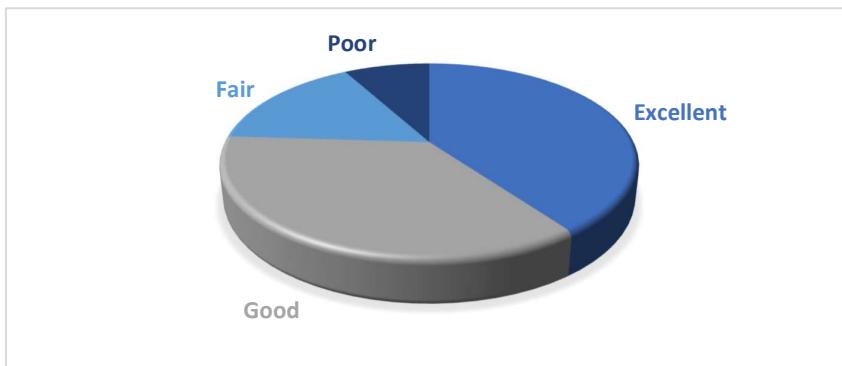

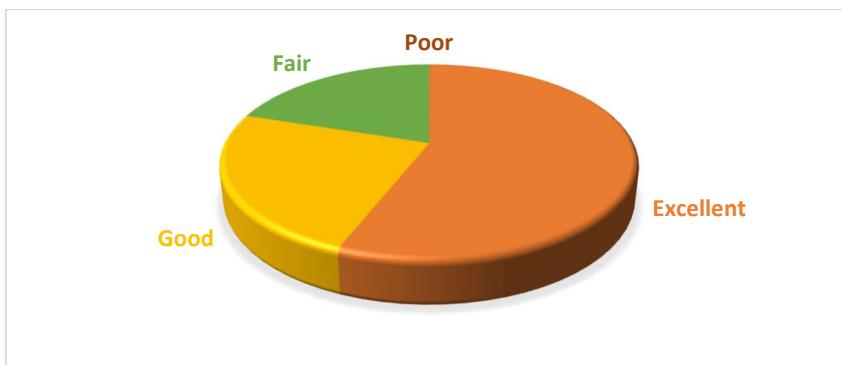

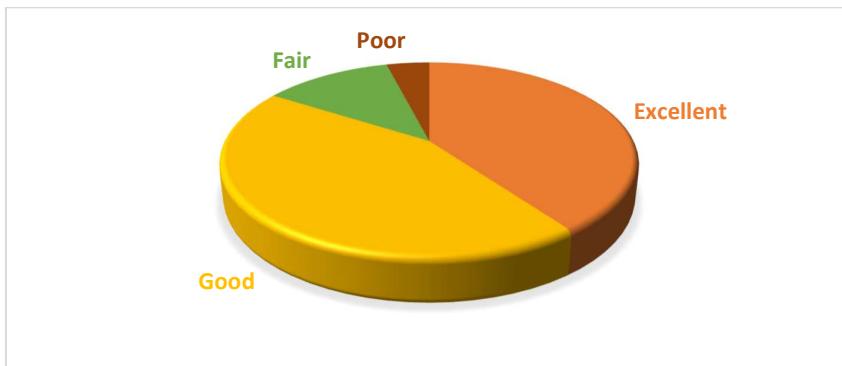

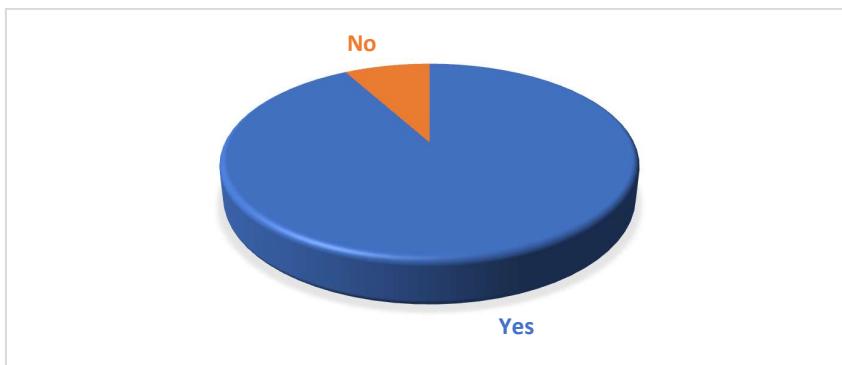


**18. Do you feel proud to be associated with our college as an Alumni?**

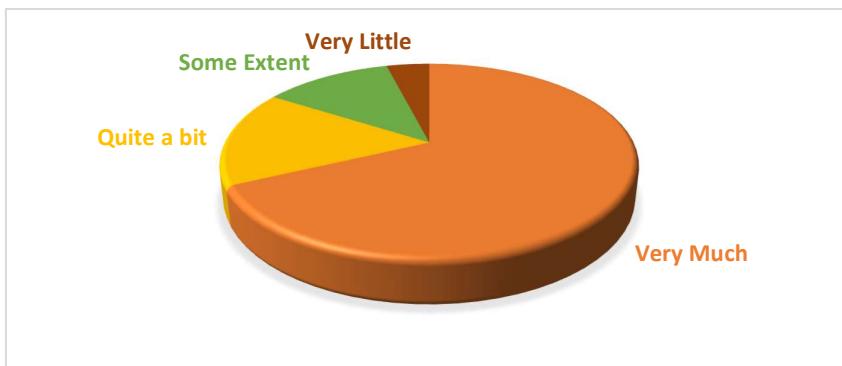

## **Alumni Feedback Analysis Report (2024-25)**

### **1. Explicit General Observation & Report**

The overall alumni sentiment is strongly positive, highlighting institutional excellence in academics, faculty quality, and student engagement. Out of 175 respondents, 100% rated the admission process positively, 96% commended faculty, and 92% praised teaching and learning. Most alumni (92%) expressed pride in the college and willingness to engage in its activities, reflecting deep institutional loyalty. Recurrent strengths include effective administration, supportive faculty, and relevant programs. However, operational facilities such as canteen services, placements, and resource infrastructure received comparatively lower satisfaction levels.

### **2. Areas Needing Improvement**

- A. Canteen Facilities: Only 60% rated good or excellent; hygiene and quality remain concerns.
- B. Training & Placement: 64% satisfaction; limited employer linkage and job readiness need attention.
- C. Extra-curricular Activities: 68% satisfaction; lack of variety and low participation noted.
- D. Library Resources & Course Relevance: 76% satisfaction; need for richer digital and applied content.
- E. Infrastructure & Labs: 80% satisfaction; modernization and maintenance required.
- F. Skill-Oriented Courses: 80% satisfaction; alignment with industry expectations can improve.
- G. Fee Structure: 80% positive but some concerns about value and transparency.
- H. Grievance Redressal: 84% satisfied; a transparent, timely system can enhance trust.

### **3. Suggested Actions**

- A. **Canteen:** Conduct hygiene audits, upgrade menus, and monitor vendors. Short-term: Improve quality and cleanliness in 3 months. Long-term: Renovate facilities and digitalize feedback by year-end.
- B. **Training & Placement:** Strengthen industry collaboration and alumni-led mentoring. Short-term: Launch placement bootcamps and employer meets. Long-term: Build a sustained recruiter network and integrate credit-bearing internships.
- C. **Extra-curricular Activities:** Reorganize clubs and inter-department events. Short-term: Reactivate 3 high-impact clubs within 6 months. Long-term: Institutionalize student-led programs and inter-college fests.
- D. **Library & Curriculum:** Expand e-resources and link courses to industry needs. Short-term: Acquire high-demand materials; subscribe to digital databases. Long-term: Annual curriculum review with alumni and industry input.
- E. **Infrastructure & Labs:** Prioritize urgent repairs and phased upgrades. Short-term: Replace critical lab tools within 6 months. Long-term: Partner with industries for modern equipment.
- F. **Skill-Oriented Courses:** Introduce micro-certifications and practical training. Short-term: Pilot 2 workshops with alumni mentors. Long-term: Collaborate with corporate trainers for certification-linked courses.
- G. **Fee & Grievance:** Increase transparency in fee structure and establish an online grievance portal with real-time tracking.

### **4. Scope for Additional Improvement**

Capitalize on alumni willingness (92%) by creating structured mentorship, donation, and internship programs. Introduce quarterly feedback surveys for faster issue tracking. Develop a digital alumni portal, promote success stories, and expand blended learning to enhance engagement and visibility.

## 5. Overall Conclusion

The feedback affirms Srikrishna College's academic excellence and alumni goodwill while identifying clear operational improvement areas. Targeted upgrades in placement, infrastructure, and student services—combined with stronger alumni-industry integration—will enhance satisfaction, employability, and reputation. With these data-driven reforms, the college can achieve sustainable institutional growth and deepen long-term alumni pride.
