## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

St. Thomas College (Autonomous), Thrissur, Kerala, India

and

Srikrishna College, Bagula, Nadia, West Bengal, India

Srikrishna College, Bagula, Nadia is an Undergraduate Institute affiliated under the University of Kalyani, West Bengal. It was established in 1952 primarily as a Commerce college and later spread its wings with Arts and Science divisions as well. Srikrishna College, hereinafter referred to as "SKC" has been accredited by NAAC (UGC) with Grade "B" in the second cycle. Located almost 100 km away from the heart of the capital city of Kolkata, SKC stands committed to spread education and an all-round holistic development primarily to the rural and semi-urban students of Bagula and its adjoining areas with its eleven departments in Humanities, six departments in Science and the department of Commerce.

#### AND

St. Thomas College, Thrissur, is a Higher Education Institution with Autonomous status, instituted by the Catholic Archdiocese of Thrissur, in the year 1919. The institution is affiliated to the University of Calicut and has been accredited by NAAC (UGC) with A Grade in the third cycle. The College provides excellent research ambience with 9 research departments and adequate research infrastructure. St. Thomas College, Thrissur hereinafter referred to as ("STCT") and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns of the second part.

(SKC and STCT hereinafter referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties")

#### WHEREAS

A. The Parties are desirous of entering into this MoU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

### SKC AND STCT HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING AS FOLLOWS:

#### OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this MoU and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, will endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop cooperation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

### 2. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

- 2.1 Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter, endeavour to take the necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:
  - a) Enrichment Programs/Conferences
  - b) Exchange of faculty;
  - c) Jointly organize international conferences; and
  - d) Any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties from time to time.

# 3. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
- 3.2 Each party will bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this MoU.

## 4. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 4.1 Each Party shall undertake to observe the secrecy of confidential information received from or supplied to the other Parties during the period of implementation of this MoU or other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.
- 4.2 All Parties agree that the provisions of this Clause shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this MoU.

# 5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 5.1 The intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the respective national laws, rules and regulations of the Parties and with other international agreements signed by both Parties.
- 5.2 The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the Parties on any publication, document and/or paper is prohibited without the prior written approval of either Party.

## 6. EFFECT OF MoU

This MoU serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied,

### 7. NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein shall be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organization of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

## 8. ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

- 8.1 This MoU will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of one (1) year.
- 8.2 This MoU may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

### 9 SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or disputes between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties without reference to any third party or international tribunal.

### 10 COMPETENT AUTHORITIES

The authorities responsible for the fulfillment of this MoU are the Department of English of SKC and the Department of English of STCT.

The foregoing record represents the understandings reached between SKC and STCT upon the matters referred to therein
