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## **1. College Profile**

Srikrishna College, with a history of seven decades of commitment of spreading higher education and all-round development, is an institution that believes in dynamic widening of its vision and translating it into real opportunity. The B Grade by the NAAC reaccredited (Cycle-II) has been a well-deserved acknowledgement of this process and has prompted the college to intensify its original commitment besides adopting several quality enhancement measures.

Presently the college has ten departments in Humanities, five departments in Science and the department of Commerce and a rich library stocked with books and journals. From the 2014-15 session the college is also offering **Honours facility in Chemistry**. Computer Science (Hons.) and Sociology(General) are to be opened in a short period. Separate Department of Physics and Geography(FB\_IV) with well equipped Laboratory. Newly constructed Science Building( FB-V) will be inaugurated very soon.

The college also has a long and illustrious history of its NSS wing.

The college believes learning to be a self-building process for the student and hence cultural, athletic, career-oriented workshops and personality building exercises form a part of the college events. **Remedial Courses** would be introduced from this academic session to ensure improvement in students' performance .

The college is a **Study Centre** for the Open and Distance Education of the University of Kalyani. The college also has a **Career Counselling Cell** to guide the out-going students and is going to soon open **Preparatory Courses for Competitive Examinations**.

The college has a commendable success rate in the University examinations and an illustrious list of alumni.

The Principal is the Head of the Institution and classes are held from 10.30 to 4.30 from Monday to Saturday. The Office remains open on all working days.

## **2. Courses Offered**

Students have to appear in 1+1+1 pattern University Examinations. Candidates taking up **Honours** stream will have to opt for **2 General subjects**. General candidates will opt for **three General subjects**.

**In Part I Examinations** all students have take up Compulsory English (50marks), Compulsory Modern Indian Language(50marks) and Environmental Science(50marks).

Students following **General course** will have to appear in the first paper each of their three elective options. Students following **Honours course** will have to appear in the first paper each of their two elective options, and the first two of their Honours papers.

**In Part II Examinations** students following **General course** will have to appear in the second and third papers each of their three elective options. Students following **Honours course** will have to appear in the second and third papers each of their two elective options, and the third and fourth of their Honours papers.

**In Part III Examinations** students following **General course** will have to appear in the fourth paper each of their three elective options. Students following **Honours course** will have to appear in the fourth paper each of their two elective options, and the remaining four papers of their Honours papers.

## **7. Admission Rules & Procedures**

A student may seek admission in the first year of the 1+1+1 B.A./B.Sc/B.Com (Hons/General) course after passing H.S. (10+1+1) in General/Vocational Stream conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education.

Students qualifying from any equivalent examination conducted by other State/Board/Council have to fulfil the following requirements:

- a. Students from Vocational Stream and other Boards/Councils will have to **pass in 5 recognized subjects**, including English, the full marks of which shall not be less than 100,
- b. Students from Vocational Stream will be allowed to apply within 3 consecutive academic sessions, including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

Candidates applying for the Honours course need to have scored in the previous qualifying examination:

- i. A minimum of 50% in aggregate and 45% in the subject or related subject **OR**
- ii. 55% marks in the subject and 45% in aggregate **OR**
- iii. 55% in aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject or any related subject

***\*\*However, candidates belonging to SC/ST shall enjoy a relaxation of 5% of marks in each of the three above cases.***

The college display a **Merit list** purely on the basis of aggregate and applied Hons. subject for HONOURS and aggregate marks for GENERAL and those who are applied for admission in to PHYSICAL EDUCATION (General) aggregate + Screening test . Admission is done through **ONLINE** in accordance with intake capacity and reservation of seats as per W.B. Govt.Order.
