About the Seminar:

The philosophical traditions of India are from the ancient era. In the course of time, Indian Philosophy has noticeably undergone suggestive and restrictive revolution due to historical and social changes along with the effects of Veda, Upanishads. The advent of eccentric change in the individual thoughts of Indian Philosophy is pretty vivid during the 19th century. Great thinkers like Rammohan, Vidyasagar, Aurobindo, Vivekananda, Gandhi, Radhakrishnan etc. had associated new directions in Indian Philosophy. As a result, the Indian Philosophical thoughts and contextures have taken a new form. The centre of arguments has been transformed from supernatural to natural. It involves the direct participation of Krishnamuti, Jawaharlal, Jayprakash, Deviprasad etc. The contemporary Indian Philosophy would have remained incomplete without their explanations of arguments. The sages from Veda and Upanishads had always worshipped knowledge as a path to salvation. Divine thinkers like Buddha, Mahavira, Goutam, Kanad, Kapil, Jaimini etc weren't in the pursuit of knowledge for achieving goals. Their influence was on the wholeness of life itself. After Shankar and Ramanucharya, philosophers like Ramananda, Kabir, Chaitanya, Ramakrishna in middle age and Rammohan, Keshav Chandra Sen , Vidyasagar, Dayananda in modern times and Neo modern philosophers like Gandhi, Rabindranath, Vivekananda, Aurobindo, Radhakrishnan, Neheru, Jayprakash Narayan, Krishnamurthy etc. have provided extremely detailed descriptions on Indian life and family by linking life with Indian Philosophy.

Guidelines of Abstract and Full Paper Submission:

- ✤ Any research paper on Indian Philosophy in Post-Independence Era or related to will be accepted. The research article must be original, authentic and have not been published elsewhere before.
- The word limit of the full paper and abstract should not exceed 3000 words & 300 words respectively.
- Full paper should be including the following norms: i) Abstract ii) Introduction iii) Methodology iv) Discussion v) Conclusion vi) References.
- References / Bibliography will be according to M.L.A Style sheet format [Name of the Author (surname first), Name of the Book / Articles, Vol., Name of the Publisher, Year of Publication, Place of Publication].
- The Articles are to be typed in Unicode front with double space and have to send word file with PDF by Email:<u>rajib@srikrishnacollegebagula.ac.in</u>
- The Article should begin with a relevant title typed in bold letter (font size 14), followed by authors' / co-Authors' name in bold letter (font size 12) and designation, affiliation, contact number, whatsApp number, valid Email ID and corresponding address.
- The full research paper is to be submitted either in English or in Sanskrit/Bengali (soft copy only) version with the structure as follows:

For Sanskrit & Bengali: Font size of Article must be 12 pt and Foot Note size 10 pt, Line and Paragraph Spacing - 1.5. as end note on A4 Paper with 2" Margins on all sides.

For English: Font size of Article must be 12 pt and Foot Note size 10 pt, Line and Paragraph Spacing - 1.5. as end note on A4 Paper with 2'' Margins on all sides.

Publication:

- Only a selected number of high quality papers will be published in the seminar Proceedings (With ISBN)
- > No additional fee shall be charged for publication (Excluding postal charges).

About the College:

Srikrishna College, with a history of seven decades of commitment of spreading higher education and all-round development, is an institution that believes in dynamic widening of its vision and translating it into real opportunity. The college believes learning to be a self-building process for the student and hence cultural, athletic, career-oriented workshops and personality building exercises form a part of the college events. College was established in the year 1950 but it did not receive its formal approval/accreditation/affiliation from the University of Calcutta. In the academic year 1952-53, Srikrishna College received the permanent seal of approval to teach the IA standard curriculum. Subsequently, the college was allowed to start the B. A. degree classes from the year 1957.

The University of Calcutta granted Srikrishna College permission to start their B. Com. Degree classes from the academic year 1962-63. In the academic year 1995-96, the college has got permission to start science stream (UG B.Sc.) with Arts and Commerce Stream. The college was affiliated with the University of Calcutta till the year 1998 and from 1999, Srikrishna College, Bagula has been under the affiliation of the University of Kalyani, West Bengal.

About the Departments:

' संस्कृतमेव हि भारतम्।' Sanskrit language and Sastra are the lives of our country India. In the study of Sanskrit language among the whole world, the contribution of Nadia district is immeasurable. Nabadip , located in Nadia, is the major centre for the study of ' Navyanayasastra' . By following the methods of learning Sanskrit, people of Bengal take pride of themselves in all over India. But due to the negligence of Sanskrit language by the people in 21st century, the study of Sanskrit language has decreased drastically; although Nadia district, the birthplace of Lord Sri Chaitanya, is still respectful to the study of this resourceful language. In the year 2012, at Bagula of this district, Department of Sanskrit was established in order to feed the hunger of knowledge and with the intense ambition of the people. During the first period of establishment, only pass course was available but the approval of Honours course in 2015 was definitely a huge addition to the study of Sanskrit.

Among eleven departments in Humanities, five departments in Science and the department of Commerce, Department of Philosophy is the traditional one. Logic, a branch of Philosophy was taught as one of the subjects of Intermediate course in the year 1952-53. In the year 1958-59 Philosophy was introduced in the graduate level as a general subject in Pass Course in our College and Honours in Philosophy has been introduced in the year 2011-12. Under the affiliation to Kalyani University from the year 2000 now Philosophy is being taught in the Honours and Programme stream under the 'CBCS Curriculum for Semesterzed Undergraduate Course' from 2018-19 sessions in parallel to the old 1+1+1 three year Degree course. In CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) curriculum 1.Core Course, 2.Elective Course, 3. Ability Enhancement Courses/ Skill Enhancement Courses are taught in six consecutive semesters of six months each.Modern Philosophy is taught in the department.

How to reach:

Srikrishna College, Bagula is well connected with Kolkata, Ranaghat and Krishnanagar by Railway and Road Transport. A daily railway transport is available between Sealdah Station (Kolkata) and Bagula Station. (Train Name- Gade Local, Distance- 106 KM). Daily railway transport is also available between Ranaghat Jn. and Bagula Station (19 KM). Bus Service is available between Krishnanagar and Srikrishna College, Bagula (20 KM).
